I need to thin my telescope collection a bit and offer the following for sale. I used each of them for many years but not recently. They would be happier gathering photons under a dark sky than dust in my basement.

No, I am not getting out of astronomy. I still have scopes which I do use when the sky permits.

1. OTA

Criterion Dynascope 8" f-8 Newtonian (RV-8)

Enhanced diagonal, SS spider, JMI focuser

Pine end rings, original mirror and cell, finder and bracket, Criterion tube rings for EQ mounting.

The tube paint job is rough but the mirror figure is excellent. This is a planetary scope with very good deep space reach. It would make an excellent Dob.

2. OTA

Celestron C-11 (11" f-10 SCT), circa 1986, ribbed back with crinkle finish.

Finder bracket, off axis solar filter (Thousand Oaks), fitted metal lens cap and storage trunk.

Tube rings (Byers) and Losmandy dovetail plate, visual back and focal reducer.

This is the scope which was mounted in the observatory prior to the arrival of the new C-14.

Except for a couple of touched-up scratches, this scope is in very good condition. I am the second owner. The original owner was Ed Gill, former, long time, HCAS member.

3. Complete scope and mount, ready to use.

6" f-6 Edmund Scientific Newtonian, red tube, circa 1975

Massive cast aluminum tripod mount, motorized.

JMI focuser, curved vane spider with enhanced 18% diagonal, original diagonal and cell.

No diffraction spikes, very good planetary and double star performance. I completed the Messier list with this scope.

Celestron "Cometron" 60mm refractor.

Good, small refractor starter scope. PVC tube, 0.965 focuser with hybrid 0.965"/1-1/4" diagonal to accept 1-1/4" eyepieces.

Lucy photographed the Venus transit with a similar scope a couple of years ago.
